Our recommendation

- **Best enjoyed:** ideal as an aperitif, served in a low glass, with ice and a slice of orange, combining the complexity of sherry with citrus notes. Also perfect for cocktails thanks to its versatility.
- **Serving temperature:** keep in the fridge. Its thermosensitive label will warn when it is at the perfect temperature for consumption (approx. 10°C), turning its logo blue.
- **Recommended preservation:** cool place and in vertical position. Once opened, store in the fridge.
- **Pairing:** perfect as an aperitif with cheese, foie gras or nuts.
- **Recommended type of glass:** white wine glass or wide glass, with ice.
